

Step 1: Downloading your music tracks

Click on the links in the email to download your purchases.

Once the download is complete, you will see a zip folder (.zip) appear in your downloads folder with the name of both the tracks above.

Step 2: Unzipping the downloaded folder

This is a compressed file and needs to be unzipped. To do this:

For PC

1. To unzip a single file or folder, open the zipped folder, then drag the file or folder from the zipped folder to a new location.

<u>OR</u>

2. To unzip all the contents of the zipped folder, press and hold (or right-click) the folder, select Extract All, and then follow the instructions.

For Mac

1. Extracting the files from an archive is as easy as double-clicking the zip fie- the files and/or folders will be deposited in the same location as the zip.

Your zip file will now be appearing as a normal folder in the same location.

To get to your music files, simple double click on this unzipped folder and the folder will open revealing two mp3's – one to be used for headphones and one to use for speakers.

By double clicking a track (.mp3 file), it will open and play in your computers default music player.

Step 3: Adding your downloaded music tracks to iTunes on your laptop

For Mac and PC:

1. Drag each music file (mp3) or folder from your downloads/or desktop to the iTunes window. If you add a folder, all the files it contains are added to your library.

OR

2. In iTunes, choose File > Add to Library or Add Folder to Library, locate the tracks or folder, and click Open.

Step 4: Getting your Soulful Soundwaves music onto your phone:


Option 1: iTunes to iPhone:

Follow these steps to manually sync the content from your computer to your iPhone:

- 1. Open iTunes.
- 2. Connect your phone to your computer using a USB cable. Your connected device appears as an icon in the upper-left corner of the iTunes window.




3. Click on the device icon . Look under Settings on the left side of the iTunes window for a list of the content types that you can sync from your iTunes library to your device.



4. Click the content type MUSIC to sync.

5. In the main iTunes window, click the tickbox next to 'Sync Music' to turn on syncing for that content type. If there's a check in the box, syncing for that content type is already on.



Note: If you see a message that your iPhone is synced with another iTunes library after clicking the box, your iPhone was previously connected to another computer. If you click "Erase and Sync" in that message, all content of the selected type on your iPhone is replaced with content from your computer. Content that you didn't turn on syncing for isn't deleted from your iPhone. You can only sync your iPhone with one iTunes library at a time.

6. Click the Apply button in the lower-right corner of the screen to save your sync settings. If syncing doesn't start automatically, click the Sync button.

Option 2: Using an android phone:

- 1. Download and install Android File Transfer on your computer.
- 2. If your screen is locked, unlock your screen.
- 3. Connect your computer to your device using a USB cable.
- 4. Locate music files on your computer and drag them into your device's Music folder in Android File Transfer.
